Story stick



Equipment

Length of stick up to 30cm long and not less than 2cm in diameter Elastic bands

Outside space

How to make your story stick

Go outside for a walk. While you are walking look out for interesting natural objects. This could be twigs, leaves, seeds, feathers and lots of other things. When you see something interesting, pick it up and use an elastic band to attach it to your stick. Continue until your stick has objects all along it.

When you have completed your story stick, use it to remember some of the things you saw, heard, felt, or learnt about on your walk.
